Located 90 miles west of Palm Springs, Lake Arrowhead is a half-hour drive from San Bernardino on the "Rim of the World Highway," designated as a national scenic byway, providing magnificent views reaching to the Pacific Ocean. Located at an altitude of 5,100 feet, this beautiful and picturesque lake community is nestled in a magnificent forest setting which surrounds a 784-acre private lake. The fresh mountain air and four-season climate is unmatched in Southern California.

Lake Arrowhead is an unincorporated area of San Bernardino County governed by the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors.

Lake Arrowhead is served by the Rim of the World Unified School District and is within commuting distance the California State University at San Bernardino, University of California Riverside, University of Redlands as well as three Junior Colleges located in Victorville, Yucaipa and San Bernardino.

Facilities/Activities

Lake Arrowhead Country Club, an 18-hole private championship golf course with swimming pool and tennis courts. The Lake Arrowhead Yacht Club, family oriented and a mecca for sail boat enthusiasts. The Lake Arrowhead Resort features a day spa and health club. The Lake Arrowhead Village, a lakefront shopping center with restaurants, outlet and specialty stores. Surrounding towns include Blue Jay, a fine shopping center located nearby, Agua Fria, Cedar Glen, Crest Park, Skyforest, Rim Forest, and Twin Peaks. Activities include water-skiing available during summer months, hiking and biking, with fishing and boating available to those living in Arrowhead Woods. The area also has an array of fine restaurants, conference and retreat centers.
